Please let this notice serve as a notification, The Borough of Swedesboro did a random check on your recycling cart, and even though there were improper items in your recycling cart this week, we picked up your recycling.

With this notice we wanted to get your attention and make you aware that only certain items are allowed to be recycled.

In July 2019 we mailed out to all our residents what is allowed and not allowed to be recycled.

In Oct 2019 we placed stickers on the recycling carts stating the same information.

Please take the time to make sure the items in your recycle cart are acceptable. The Borough of Swedesboro will be randomly checking your recycling cart and if your cart is found to have incorrect items in it, your cart will not be emptied that week. You will have to correct your container and we will pick up the following week.

- Corrugated Cardboard (Dry & Clean)
- Paper Towel & Toilet Paper Roll
- Junk Mail
- Books

ALUMINUM, STEEL & TIN CANS:

- Soda & Alcohol Cans
- Food Cans
- Cookie Tins

PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS #1 & #2 ONLY

- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Laundry Detergent
- Soda/Water
- Milk Jugs




- NO** Plastic bags

- NO** Plastic film, wrap, or bubble wrap
- NO** Pizza boxes
- NO** Styrofoam of ANY kind
- NO** Frozen food, ice cream, or frozen juice containers
- NO** Organic material or food waste
- NO** Hoses or hangers

NO NEED TO REMOVE:

Paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, metal fasteners, cellophane address windows, rubber bands, spiral bindings, plastic tabs.

The following are your curbside recycling container's DIRTY DOZEN. Please follow these simple rules when deciding which items to place in your container. **WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT!**
