**STATE OF EMERGENCY
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTER

TO ALL RESIDENTS AND PERSONS WITHIN GLOUCESTER COUNTY,
NEW JERSEY, AND TO ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE COUNTY
GOVERNMENT OF GLOUCESTER COUNTY:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested under the laws of the State of New Jersey, including but not limited to N.J.S.A. App. A:9-30 et seq., and all other applicable statutes and ordinances, a local disaster emergency has been declared to exist within Gloucester County; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorize the promulgation of such orders, rules, and regulations as are necessary to meet the various problems which have arisen or may arise due to such emergency; and

WHEREAS, a significant winter storm event has resulted in historic snowfall totals, blizzard conditions, sustained heavy accumulation, reduced visibility, and hazardous roadway conditions throughout Gloucester County; and

WHEREAS, continued snowfall, equipment strain, and the inability to maintain safe travel conditions on primary and secondary roadways pose a direct threat to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Gloucester County; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that all areas within Gloucester County are designated disaster areas and that immediate emergency measures must be implemented to ensure public safety, maintain emergency response access, preserve the orderly flow of traffic, and protect persons and property affected by these conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the aforesaid laws, the following regulations are hereby promulgated and shall remain in effect until this emergency declaration is rescinded. These regulations are in addition to all other applicable laws of the State of New Jersey and Gloucester County:

1. No Street Parking Restriction

All roadways within Gloucester County are hereby subject to a No Street Parking restriction. Vehicles shall not be parked on County or municipal roadways so as to allow plow operations and emergency

vehicles unobstructed access for snow removal and emergency response operations.

2. **Travel Advisory**

Residents are strongly encouraged to refrain from operating motor vehicles unless travel is necessary for emergencies or by essential personnel. Limiting roadway traffic is necessary to allow public works crews and emergency responders to focus on maintaining critical infrastructure and designated emergency routes.

3. **Deployment of Additional Resources**

Contract snow removal crews have been requested and authorized to assist Gloucester County Public Works due to the sustained and significant rate of snowfall. Additional operational resources are being deployed to support ongoing snow removal operations and the maintenance of emergency routes.

This declaration shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until conditions improve and it is determined that the threat to public safety has been mitigated.
